Event Report

Dr Vasanthi Srinivasan an eminent professor of HR from IIM B provided her valuable insights on teaching learning process. COVID had caused a significant disruption in the teaching learning process, all the institutes had to move to the online teaching mode. The transition to this mode impact the learning abilities of students. Dr. Vasanthi enumerated the basic 5 step cycle of teaching learning process

Prior Knowledge: It is the knowledge that students already have stored in their memories before starting a new topic.

Presenting New Material: Teachers try to link prior knowledge of the students and use abstract ideas and a multi-sensory approach while teaching them.

Challenge: Teachers set Graphical and non-linguistic tasks for students. The students here learn to work effectively in groups and grow their cooperative and collaborative skills.

Feedback: Here, teachers show students how to improve their skills.

Repetition: Since the teaching-learning process helps students in creating long-term memories, it is important that this process is repeated several times with an uninformed time gap for the welfare of the students.

She then went on to explain as to how hybrid mode of learning and online learning are impacting the process. She focused on how the medium can be made more active and interactive. She also discussed a few research articles on the same.

The session concluded with Question and Answers session.
