<b>Event Report</b>
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<p>Dr Srinivas Sridharan an eminent professor of Marketing at Monash Business School discussed the teaching learning process from the perspective of Conversational Framework. The conversational framework is a student centric learning process, where the student is considered to be in the centre of the process. The conversational framework emphasises interactions between teachers, learners, peers and the learning environment at both the conceptual and practice level. The conversational framework was devised by Laurillard in 2002. Dr. Srinivas emphasized on the 6 types of learning activities involved in the conversational framework which are acquisition, practice, discussion, inquiry, collaboration and production in Teaching as a design science. He also further mentioned that having this framework for consideration is particularly powerful when learning experiences differ across modes (e.g. online or face-to-face) to ensure learners are experiencing a mix of learning activities and interactions likely to achieve the learning outcomes. He used examples from his teaching experience which further enriched the session.</p>
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The session concluded with Question and Answers session.
