

Increased Self-awareness: Students gained greater self-awareness through reflective discussions, enabling them to recognize their strengths and areas for improvement.


Application in Real-world Scenarios: Participants expressed enthusiasm for applying the skills and strategies learned during the exercise in their academic and professional pursuits.
