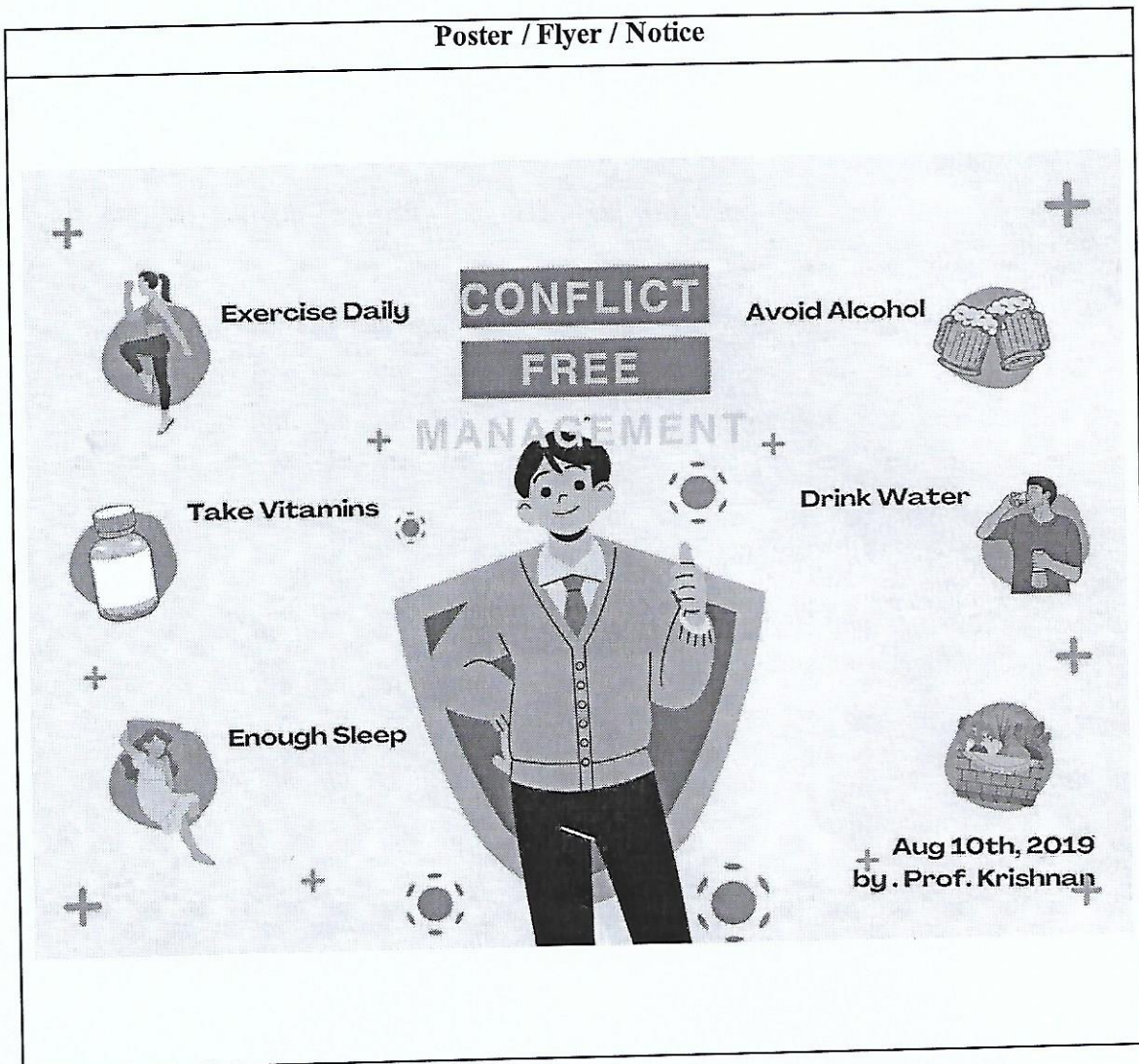

Strengthened Relationships: The team-building exercise helped forge stronger bonds and relationships among participants, contributing to a sense of community and belonging.

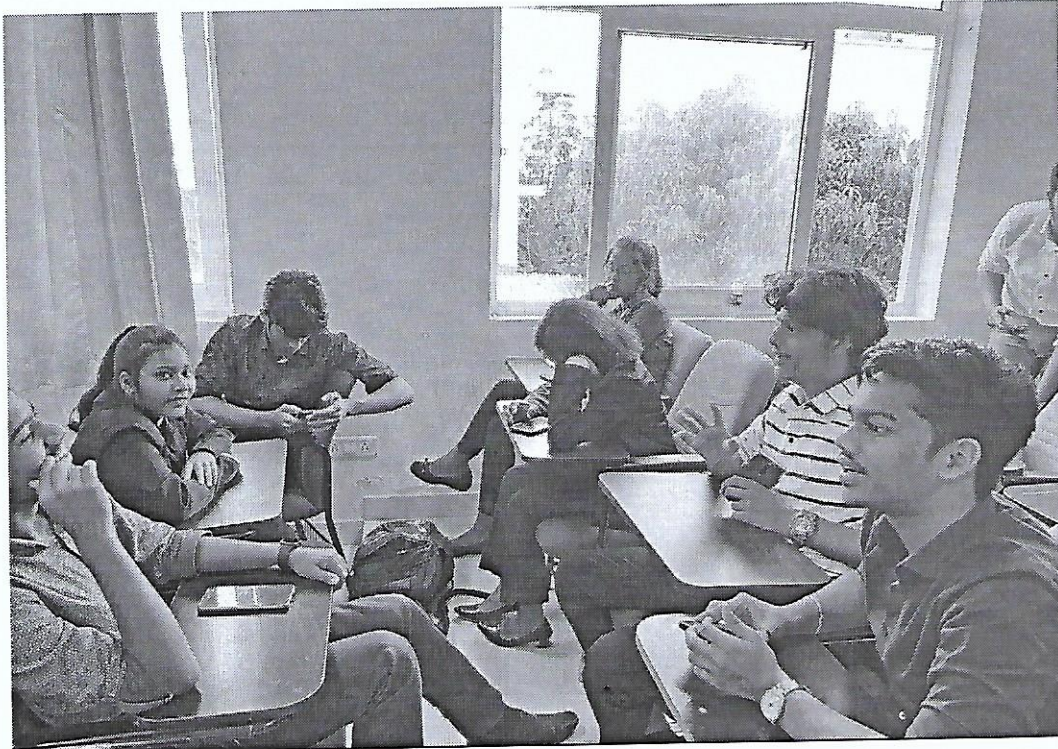
Increased Self-awareness: Students gained greater self-awareness through reflective discussions, enabling them to recognize their strengths and areas for improvement.
