Empowered Mindset: The workshop instilled in students a sense of empowerment and responsibility to lead with integrity and empathy.

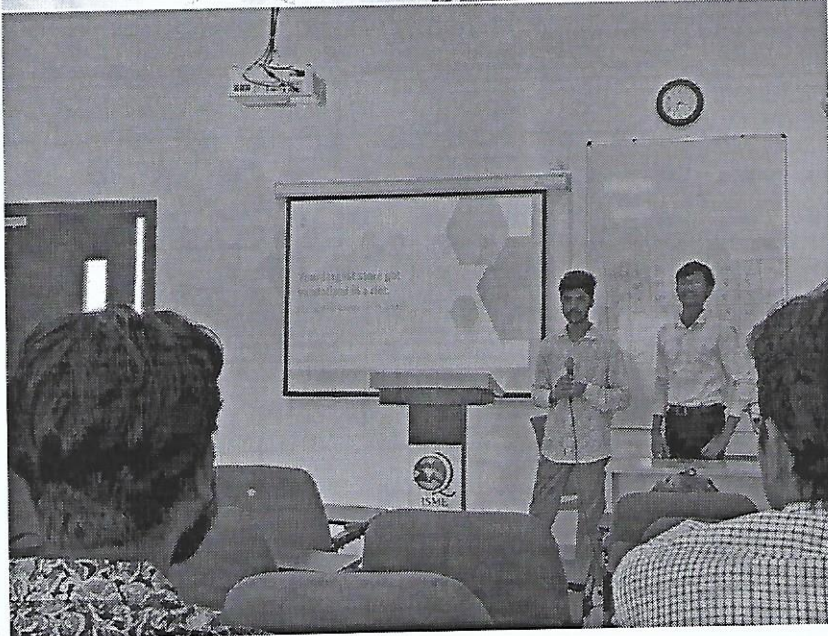
Networking Opportunities: Participants had the chance to network with peers and guest speakers, expanding their professional connections and support network.
