#### Highlights:

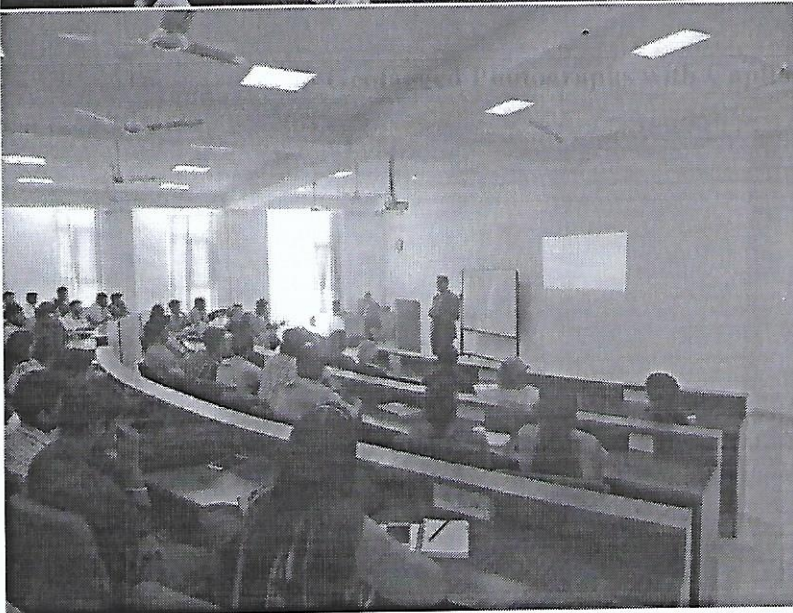
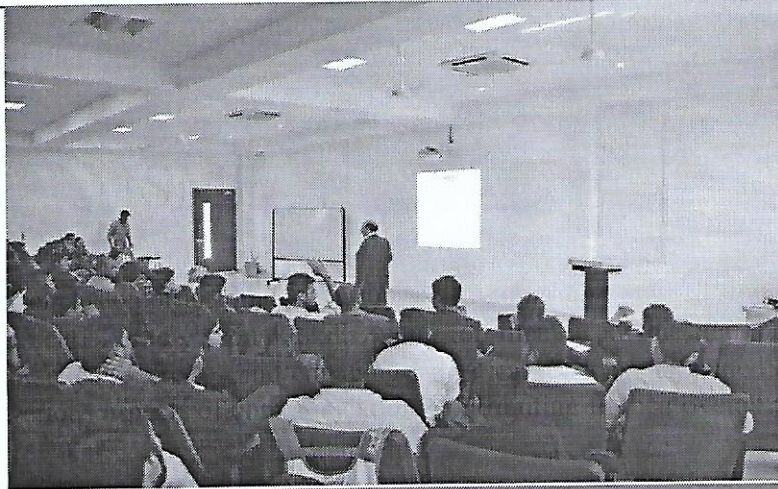
1. **Effective Communication Strategies:** The workshop commenced with an overview of effective communication techniques. Students learned the importance of clarity, active listening, and empathy in communication.
