However, in recent years, the lake has faced significant degradation due to pollution, encroachment, and neglect. This report aims to outline the current status of the lake and propose conservation measures to restore and preserve its ecological integrity.

Status: Chembanalli Lake suffers from pollution caused by untreated sewage discharge, agricultural runoff, and solid waste dumping. These pollutants have led to eutrophication, resulting in algal blooms, depleted oxygen levels, and loss of biodiversity. Additionally, encroachment along the lake's banks has reduced its water retention capacity and disrupted natural habitats.

Conservation Measures: Pollution Control: Implement strict regulations to prevent further pollution by enforcing proper waste management practices, installing sewage treatment plants, and conducting regular water quality monitoring.

- 1.Habitat Restoration: Undertake habitat restoration projects to revive degraded areas, including wetland restoration, reforestation of buffer zones, and removal of invasive species.
- 2.Community Engagement: Engage local communities through awareness campaigns, workshops, and participatory conservation programs to foster stewardship and encourage sustainable use of lake resources.
- 3.Legal Protection: Advocate for legal protection of the lake and its surrounding ecosystem through the establishment of protected areas, conservation easements, and zoning regulations to prevent further encroachment and ensure long-term conservation.

Chembanalli Lake is a valuable natural asset that requires urgent conservation efforts to reverse the damage caused by pollution and encroachment. By implementing the proposed measures and fostering community involvement, we can restore the lake's health and ensure its sustainability for future generations
